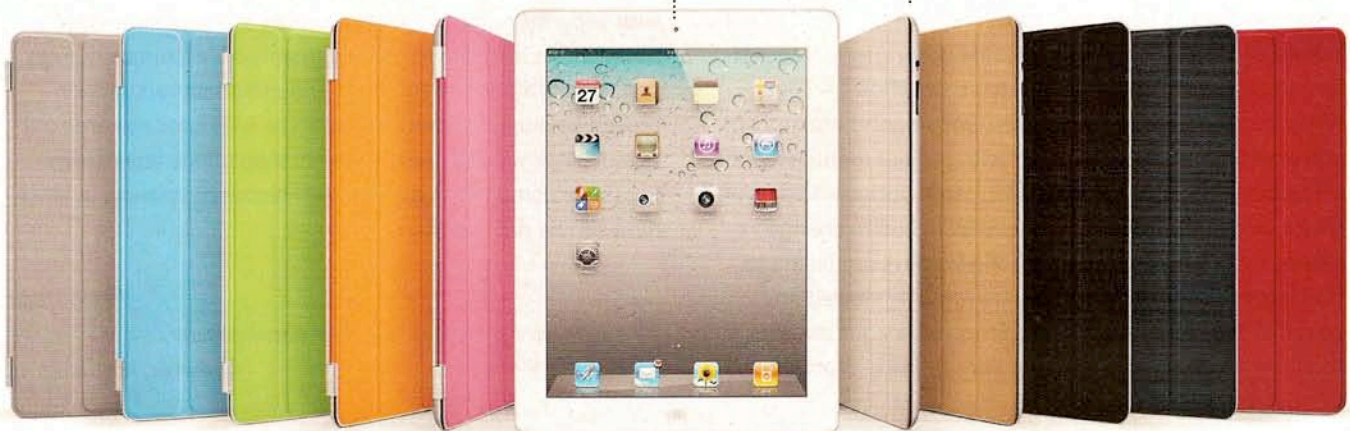


TimeLog: Record your hours on the go
